

Geographic coverage - 131 Range States







- 11 species of Old World vultures added to Raptors MoU at MoS2
- Recently published paper in *Biological Conservation* on 'State of the World's Raptors'
- Unsolicited interest expressed by certain East and SouthEast Asian countries to sign

Benefits or otherwise of extending Raptors MoU

TAG is requested to:

- a) Consider what, if any, technical or practical benefits might accrue from extending the geographic scope of the Raptors MOU;
- b) Suggest criteria that could be applied to identify those countries to which the geographic range of the MOU could be extended to enhance the effectiveness of the MOU; and,
- c) Assess the implications of the proposed criteria by compiling a list of Range States that should be considered for inclusion within the geographic range of the Raptors MOU at MOS3.
